VINEYARD

The fruit is grown at the Almo Creek Ranch Vineyard in San Luis Obispo County. The southeastern San Luis Obispo County site enjoys a 50-degree drop in temperature from day to night, allowing grapes to reach full maturity and develop ideal natural acids. The result is a Rosé with an alluring color, more intense fruit character, ripeness and fuller body.

VINIFICATION

Summerland winemaker used the saignée method to produce the rosé, removing color of the Grenache from the must. The winemaker decided to use the skin-contact method, putting the lot of de-stemmed Grenache grapes in a tank, cold-soaking for 24 hours, followed by removing the must and then pressing it.



TASTING NOTES

This delightful San Luis Obispo County appellation Grenache Rosé has hints of raspberry and tropical fruit on the nose and pallet. A refreshing summer sipper to be enjoyed with sea food, soft cheese or a light salad. This delicate wine is crisp with a bright mouth feel; perfect for a warm day. Please enjoy chilled.
