VINEYARDS

Our Chardonnay is sourced from the Sierra Madre Vineyard located in Santa Barbara's premier Northern wine growing region. These grapes are accompanied by a smaller source from the Paradise Road Vineyard located in the Santa Ynez Valley. Both vineyards are known for bringing in a high-quality fruit making for a great Chardonnay.

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

With one of the coldest vineyards in California, there is a level of depth in complexity for this Chardonnay. To add to that, the wine was aged for 11 months on lees in 15% new French Oak barrels providing the wine a buttery and fuller-bodied profile. For balance the wine was then aged in a neutral wood, adding delicacy and smoothness on the palate.

TASTING NOTES

This exquisite Chardonnay retains a sweet, honey like aroma, with a nicely integrated French Oak finish. The wine has a smooth, rich, and buttery body bringing ease to the palate, with notes of pear, vanilla, citrus, and caramel adding to its sweet & rich complexity.
